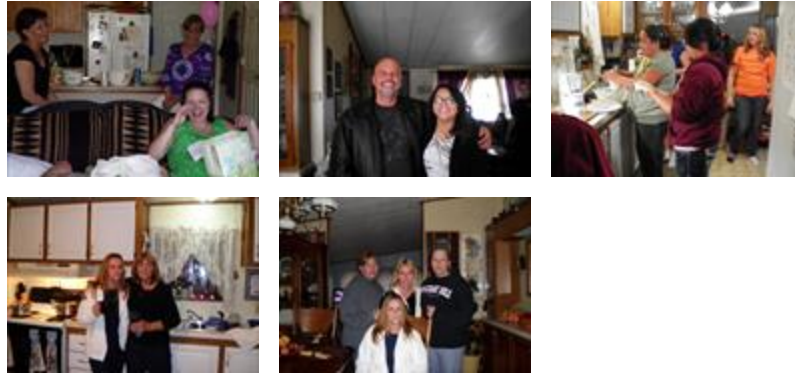
*My dearest brother, Lonnie,
