Brock Wade Lindsay tragically passed away on Saturday, August 26, 2023, in Manson, WA, at the age of 40, due to a farm vehicle accident.

Brock was born in Seattle, WA, to Sandra and Jim Lindsay on December 8, 1982. He attended Villa Academy, Seattle Prep, and then Montana State University, receiving a Civil Engineering degree with a minor in business.
