



Clofas James Abbott

April 28, 1926 - December 14, 2016

Clofas (Cleo) Abbott, 90, passed away Dec. 14, 2016 at Bonaventure Assisted Living in Wenatchee, Wash.

Cleo was born in Ringold, Oklahoma, April 28, 1926, to Luther and Maggie Abbott, and entered the Army in May 1944, serving in the Asiatic / Pacific Theater in the Philippines, during which time he was wounded in action. He received two Purple Hearts, a Bronze Star, and an Outstanding Marksman's Award, and numerous others.

Discharged from service in October 1945, he returned to the Brewster-Bridgeport area and married Pauline Hammons on Nov. 24, 1945 in Pateros, Wash. Married nearly 70 years, Pauline passed away in March of 2015.

Cleo worked as an Operating Engineer and was an orchardist in the Brewster-Chelan area. He loved to hunt and fish. After moving to Lake Chelan in 1972, he enjoyed many years on the lake with their family.

He is survived by daughters Linda Robinson of Chelan, Wash., and Judy Clemons of Grants Pass, Oregon; 5 grandchildren; 11 great-grandchildren, and was preceded in death by wife, Pauline, grandson Jeff in 2002, son-in-laws John Clemons in 2010 and Roger Robinson in 2013.

Graveside services were held on Saturday, Dec. 17, 2016, at 11 a.m., Bridgeport City Cemetery.
