Deborah Christine “Debbie” (Barnett) Haskins passed away peacefully in her home, after an extended illness on November 2, 2023. She was born in Chelan, WA, to David and Ruth Ann (Little) Barnett on September 5, 1950. She moved to Arizona with her mom when she was young, and lived there most of her childhood, before returning to Manson, WA, where she graduated from high school in 1968.

While she attended high school, she met the love of her life, Steve Haskins, and they were married on October 5, 1968. They had just celebrated 55 years of marriage together.

Together, Debbie and Steve lived in Chelan, Chelan Falls, WA, Arizona, Quincy, WA, and Grand Coulee, WA, together.

In 1974, they welcomed a daughter, Stephanie, and in 1978, they welcomed another daughter, Heather.

Debbie worked at Cascadian Fruit Shippers and other packing sheds throughout Chelan and Manson, throughout her career, and retired, in 1998.
