He took pride in consistently being in the top most percentage of growers in the Trout warehouse during his farming career.

He was a member of the Lake Chelan Eagles and Wenatchee Valley Super Oval.

He was preceded in death by his parents, John G. and Maude Dietrich.

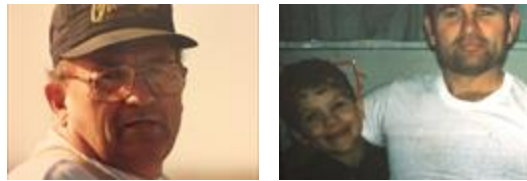
