



## Edith Tackett

January 18, 1931 - January 30, 2013

Edith M. Tackett died on January 30th, 2013. She was 82 years young. She married Harvey Tackett and remained in Chelan until relocating to Seattle in 1964. Edith was employed by Sears, Roebuck and Co. and then Boeing until her retirement in 1991. After retiring, she and Nelson relocated to Mansfield.
