



## Florence M. Sines

January 31, 1918 - July 6, 2017

Florence Mildred Sines (McFarlin) was born January 31, 1918 in Mansfield, Washington, to Emmitt and Adeline McFarlin. She died at Regency Wenatchee on July 6, 2017 at the age of 99. Her family moved to Chelan when she was a small child and she attended school there, graduating in 1936. After graduation, she worked for the Forest Service for 5 years, then moved to Seattle when she married Douglas C. Sines on Dec. 28, 1941.
