Chelan-Harry "Lee" Hanford, 88, a long-time resident of Bridgeport, died Saturday, February 9, 2013, at Regency Manor Car Center.

He was born September 30, 1924, at Bridgeport, the son of Ralph "Emerson" and Margaret (Lily) Hanford. He was raised at Bridgeport and was graduated from Bridgeport High School in 1942.

In 1942, he enlisted in the U.S. Army where he served in the European Theater through 1946. In 1950, he was recalled to the Army where he served in Korea until 1951.

In 1948, he was married to Joan Beard.

Lee was a life-long wheat and cattle rancher in the Bridgeport area. He was also a member of the American Legion Post 97 and was a past commander.

Survivors include his wife, Joan, of the home; a son, Lee J. Hanford, of Bridgeport; a daughter, Jo A Miller (Marshall), of Chelan; two Grandsons: Charles (Jenna) Miller, of Pateros; Jordan (Rachel) Miller, of Wenatchee; Two great grandsons: Henry Lee Miller and Remington Miller; a brother, Francis Hanford, of Fresno, CA; and a sister, Margaret Socci, of Bridgeport.
