Herbert H. Goedde was born on 1/29/1915 in Butte Nebraska to William and Ida Goedde. He passed on 2/20/2013. He was preceded to Chelan by his brother Leo who drowned in the lake. Herb and his brother Joe came to Chelan to escort the body back to Nebraska which started the family migration west. Herb served his country during World War II assisting in maintaining the supply line through Iran to ally Russia. Following his discharge he joined his family in Chelan. He met and married Mary Ann Faletto in Chelan on 6/22/1948. John Goedde and Sue (Goedde) Lain were born to the couple. Herb was employed in Chelan by various dealers representing International Harvester and retired from Valley Tractor. His hobbies included gardening, fishing and being a great Mr. Fix-It. Herb was preceded in death by his wife Mary, brothers Leo, Joe and Ivo; sisters Julia, Hilda, Marie and Irene; and grand daughter Melissa. He is survived by his children John (Terri) and daughter Sue (Sam), grandson Brian and his sister Zita; sister in laws Erma and Mary and many nieces and nephews.
