



## Roland W "Ron" Sloan

August 23, 1932 - March 12, 2022

Roland William "Ron" Sloan, of Chelan, WA, passed away on March 12, 2022, of natural causes. Ron was born on August 23, 1932, in Tacoma, WA, to John Delbert and Alice Knittle Sloan. He grew up in Morton, WA. He graduated from Morton High School in 1948, and went on to Central Washington University, where he graduated in 1952, with a Masters in Science. He served for 4 years in the U.S. Air Force.

On August 4, 1952, he married Nancy McGlenn, in Spokane, WA. They made their home in Chelan, WA, their entire married life, until Nancy passed away on September 7, 2011.

Ron worked for 7 years as a teacher in the Chelan School District teaching science. He then went on to work for 2 years at the Lower Tavern, and finished his career at Entiat High School, working there for 12 years. During this time, he also worked as a carpenter and land developer. Ron was also the mayor of Chelan. He enjoyed being outdoors; especially golfing, hunting, and trap shooting.
