



## Thomas Georgianna

November 15, 1945 - August 26, 2023

Tom Georgianna, 77, passed away Saturday, August 26th, 2023, in Chelan, Washington. Tom grew up in Southern California going to college and eventually earning a Ph.D. in Regional Science at Indiana University. He worked as an Environmental Program Manager and Senior Statistician at King County Environmental Labs before retiring in 2010 to Eastern Washington with the love of his life, Kathleen Irwin Georgianna.

He is survived by Kathy and his two children, Tom Georgianna of Dana Point, California, and Leigh Giorgianni McLerran of Grapevine, Texas, as well as a sister-in-law, grandchildren, and many cousins, nieces, and nephews.
